

## Tariff – Find A Tariff

<p>The “Tariff - Find a Tariff” lets allows you view tariff rates by selecting from one data source, one market, one year, and one or all duty codes.</p>
<p>This tool is useful for determining tariff rates at the national level, as well as for comparing rates applied to various trade agreements.</p>
<p>In this example, we will look at the tariff rates applied by Indonesia for its export of roasted, unground coffee.</p>
<p>Select the Data Source, Market, Year, Duty Code, Nomenclature, and Tier.</p>
<p>For Product, you can either input “coffee” or the product code.</p>
<p>For Tariff Line, select the national level classification for the coffee product.</p>
<p>Select the attributes to be displayed in your report, then click “Proceed” when you are done.</p>
<p>In the Result View window, we can see the tariff rates applied by Indonesia for roasted, unground coffee.</p>
<p>We have the MFN duty rate</p>
<p>as well as the preferential tariff rates for individual partners.</p>
<p>There is also a tariff rate for countries belonging to the ASEAN group</p>
<p>To determine the member countries, take the Partner code.</p>
<p>Go to “TRAINS Tariff Measures and Preference Beneficiaries”, and input the same code in the “Region Code” filter.</p>
<p>These are the countries that are included in that trade agreement.</p>
<p>To download your report, click on the Download button.</p>
<p>Enter the Job Name, Job Description, and select the file format.</p>
<p>Your report will be displayed once it is available for downloading.</p>
<p>Click on the “Save” icon to download your report to your personal drive.</p>
