Advanced Query: Bulk Download (TRAINS)

The Bulk Download tool lets you download a large amount of data for both Preferential and Most-
Favored-Nation (MFN) rates from UNCTAD's TRAINS database at the 6-digit level of the Harmonized
System.
To use this tool, start by entering the Query Name and Description.
Then select the Duty Type and Estimate Method.
Duty Types that include AVEs are calculated using the UNCTAD Method
You can download the entire dataset by choosing "Download All Reporters and Years".
Since files are downloaded by year and country, this option will yield a large number of files that could
take up significant storage space.
Another option is to use Selective Download.
This lets you download data on specific countries and years.
Select the Duty Type, and then select the Estimate Method if applicable.
Select the countries you want to include,
And then select the years.
Tick this option if you want to download the latest available year for each country.
Click "Download" after you have finalized your selections.
Your report will contain numerous codes when you open it. This system of classification is done in order
to make the files smaller and easier to download.
To understand these codes, you can refer to the available reference materials.
The Help pdf file contains definitions of the variables in the column header of your downloaded report.
Use the Country List to determine the Reporter, Partner and ExcludedFrom countries. A 3-digit numeric
code represents a single country.
An alpha-numeric code represents a group of countries. Use the TRAINS Preference Beneficiaries to view
the countries in that group.
To translate the product code, you can use either version of the Product List.
