

Advanced Query – Trade Outcomes Indicators

<p>The Trade Outcomes Indicators tool lets you query the UN COMTRADE database and construct up to twenty-one different indicators that are classified into four dimensions of trade performance: Orientation and Growth, Export Diversification, Export Sophistication, and Export Survival.</p>
<p>To get started, enter a Query Name and Description.</p>
<p>Next, select a Trade Performance Category, or in this case, a Trade Indicator Group.</p>
<p>Click on the “Question” icon to know more about your selection.</p>
<p>You can choose to run the query for all indicators in that Trade Performance Category, or you can select a single indicator.</p>
<p>Again, click on the “Question” icon for more details on the indicator you selected.</p>
<p>Additional fields may have to be filled, depending on the indicator you selected in your query.</p>
<p>Click “Save and Submit” when you are done.</p>
<p>You will be redirected to the “Download and View Results” page where you can check on the progress of your query.</p>
<p>You can click on the “Refresh” icon to see if your report has been processed.</p>
<p>When your report is ready, click on the “View” icon.</p>
<p>In the Report Columns Selection window, you can choose which attributes to add or remove from your report.</p>
<p>A brief description is displayed when you click a variable.</p>
<p>Click “Proceed” when you are done.</p>
<p>In the Result View window, you will find a detailed breakdown of your report.</p>
<p>You can click on the column headers to sort your data.</p>
<p>And you can use the filter option to display a specific set of data.</p>
<p>To view the chart, close the current window, and then click on the “Chart” icon.</p>
<p>It should be noted that different charts are generated, depending on the indicator you queried.</p>
<p>Additional information can be viewed when you hover over the data points of your chart.</p>
<p>The right panel lets you control which data is displayed in your chart.</p>
<p>Click on the “refresh” button to return your chart to its original state.</p>
<p>The “Export” option allows you to save your chart in different formats.</p>
<p>Click on “Additional Charts” for more visualization options.</p>
<p>Fill in the required fields, then click “Show Chart”</p>
<p>You can print the generated image or download it in multiple formats.</p>
<p>To download the data you queried, close the current window and then click on the “Download” icon.</p>
<p>Select the variables you want to include in your report, select the File Format, and then click on the “Download” button.</p>
<p>Finally, click on the “Save” icon to download the report to your personal drive.</p>
<p>A copy of your query will be saved in the system, allowing you to access and modify your report for future use.</p>
<p>To learn more about the four dimensions of trade performance, as well as the twenty-one indicators you can generate with this tool, please refer to the user manual.</p>
